\*\*\*Road Commission will supply ground labors and chipper for clean-up.

\*\*\*Minimum 4 hour day and 24 hour notice. We will not pay for travel time.

\*\*\*Limbs will be cut flush to the tree. All limbs will require an aerial bucket truck that can extend up to 30' from ground level.

\*\*\* Contractor must provide all certifications for the aerial truck and operator.

Insurance requirements

The Roscommon County Road Commission requires that a “**Certification of Insurance**” be on file prior to allowing work within the right-of-way of any road under the jurisdiction of the Road Commission.

The certificate of insurance shall contain or include the following:

1. Board of County Road Commissioners and Roscommon County Road Commission and all employees named as addition insured to all coverage.
2. General liability coverage - \$1,000,000 each occurrence.
3. Automotive liability - \$1,000,000 each occurrence.
4. Worker’s compensation – statutory limits.

The Roscommon County Road Commission is accepting sealed bids for their seasonal supply of grader blades quantity (800). These blades need to be a Curved Double Bevel Hi-Carbon and/or Curved Single Bevel Through Hardened blades. Bidders must supply specifications and literature with each blade bid. Delivery of blades need to be prior to November/December of 2026.

- Blade Dimensions:** Minimum specification: ¾” X 8” X 6’  
 \*\*Will consider other sizes. \*\*
- Blade Length:** Length shall not be exceeded and must not be shorter than 1/8” specified in order to fit to moldboard length in various combinations. Ends shall be cleanly cut.
- Blade Punching:** All blades shall be furnished with appropriate bolt holes punched or drilled as required per SAE specification No. J740.
- Blade Marking:** Each blade shall have a legible identifying mark indicating a special hardened type blade.
- Camber Tolerance:** The actual (edge straightness) shall be measured at the mid-point from a straight line extending from one end of the edge to the other. Maximum camber shall not exceed 1/8” for all lengths 0 feet through 6 feet.
- Warranty:** This blade is to be unconditionally guaranteed against breakage under normal operating conditions. Warranty does not include hardware or labor for removal and installation
